Christmas Mission Trip to San Telmo December 21—23

Christmas is a time for giving, but unlike the world which emphasizes material gifts, we know that Christmas is about giving the gift of eternal life. During the Christmas mission trip to Mexico from December 21—23, we desire “to be a touch of mercy, a light of hope and a cause of salvation for lost souls” in San Telmo and Tijuana.

The mission team will be distributing the 1200 gift bags that brothers and sisters assembled at the **Christmas Gift Outreach**. It will be a blessing to witness the joy of those who receive gift bags

Our Lord has put on our hearts to assist inmates in the **Tijuana Jail**. In Mexico, you are guilty until proven innocent and people are often incarcerated for a year before their trial date because they cannot afford the \$100—\$200 bail bond. Our hope and prayer is to raise \$1500 so that eight to ten prisoners can embark on a “**Freedom Walk**” to a new life for Christmas. This will be a wonderful opportunity to demonstrate Jesus’ love and compassion to the inmates and their families.

There will also be a special baptismal service inside the Tijuana jail.

In **San Telmo**, a small migrant farming village two hours south of Ensenada, we built a church five years ago. This year we will be finishing the new addition to the Christian school that we constructed two years ago. With God’s grace, we plan to finish the interior, paint the five school buildings and pour concrete for a new playground. Funds are needed to complete the work and



we prayerfully ask for your support.

This **Christian school** is a light in a place of darkness that will serve children from preschool to sixth grade. In addition, there will be Christian programs and adult education classes. Again, these programs can only be made possible through your generous contributions.

Once again, there will be a special Christmas program for the children of San Telmo and a **community love feast for 700**. All of the gifts and clothing will be distributed with the presentation of the Gospel. Please join with us as we help to celebrate Jesus’ birth by bringing His love to others in Mexico.
