Scholarships for Students in Sichuan ... There are a total of 64 sponsors from the Bread of Life Church in Torrance and from the Grace Ling Liang Church in Toronto, one sponsor for each qualified high school student in earthquake stricken Sichuan, providing him/her with tuition, room, and board at US\$90 per semester, and communicating with the student by letter or email at whatever pace comfortable. Sam Lee and Lily Lang of the Torrance Bread of Life Church were in three cities (Guanghan, Mianzu, and Anxian) of Sichuan together with members of the Beijing International Mandarin Church to meet students, faculty members and local church pastors on Nov. 3rd and 4th. Besides being able to talk to them on first-hand basis, Sam and Lily also investigated the possibility of operating an English Camp in one of the churches in Sichuan next year. Teaching English is in great demand in China and can be used as tool to preach the Gospel to people there.

Participating the Hong Kong District Celebration ... Rev. Dr. Wilson Lee (President), Elder Paul Lam (VP) and Jimmy Chui (Treasurer), with brothers and sisters of Toronto Grace Ling Liang Church attended the 60th Anniversary Celebration of Rev. Dr. Timothy Dzao's Ling Liang ministry in Hong Kong. All sixteen Ling Liang churches in Hong Kong gathered together in the Chinese University of Hong Kong on 10/25/09 to have joint worship service. Ex-president of LLWWEMA, now part time pastor of Orange County Bread of Life Church of USA was the speaker to encourage all Ling Liang brothers and sisters in Hong Kong.

A short give-away ceremony on 10/30/2009 was conducted. It was a rare chance to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ in front of the government officials, handicapped, and their families.

The registration fee for each person is \$200 which includes 1 banquet, 3 lunches and 3 dinners. If a registrant chooses to tour Disneyland on 9/14/10, there is an additional fee of \$65. Invitation letters, registration forms, and General Assembly schedule are being forward to all Ling Liang Churches and their Districts.

The team had met with leaders of different organizations on Campus: Campus Crusade for Christ, Christians on Campus and Chinese Students and Scholars Association. The Campus is expanding with addition of different Schools. Students are expected to increase from 2,700 in 2008 to 25,000 in 2038.

The team had also attended the Sunday worship service at a local church, Yosemite Church and met with their pastor. Currently there is no Chinese speaking church in the area despite a number of overseas students from China.

We pray that God will be preparing someone (seminary-graduated, minister, pastor) with a burden on church planting, a servant heart for discipleship training to prepare God's people for works of service, with "go-out" mentality, and nurture the Gospel Station to become a vibrant community with every member on the mission to build up the body of Christ.

Mission Trip to Mexicali, Mexico (September 5 – 6, 2009)









The Torrance Bread of Life Church led a team of 30 people from five different churches to perform free medical services for the residents of Mexicali. The team included 6 licensed doctors and 5 registered nurses and was able to attend to 100 patients in two days. Each patient received a gift on his way out. The Mexicali Chinese Association provided its facility for our use and took the team out to dinner. On the first day the Mexicali Mayor's wife came to welcome and thank the team for its effort. There was a one-and-half hour service in the morning of the second day, featuring singspiration, testimonies and refreshments. Mexicali is one of the mission sites designated in the Torrance Bread of Life Church's master plan. An after-school care facility is planned to care for children between 6 and 12 on weekdays. On weekend the facility will be used as a mission site conducting fellowship, Bible study, worship, etc.

Torrance Bread of Life led a team of 63 people from 6 different churches to Tijuana, Mexico, to preach the Gospel to the inmates in the Tijuana jail and to provide them with lunch and gift packages containing soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, toilet paper, face towel and saver. Messages were given by Pastor Paul Suh, Cris O'Neal, and Jose Luis who was an inmate himself before. The jail visits 2 to 3 times a year have changed the hostile and hopeless atmosphere in the jail to an atmosphere of peace and hope. Many inmates have received Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.

In the afternoon of Oct. 3, the team visited the "Oct. 3" Church which was having a second floor added on to the existing one level building. All construction was done by a team of volunteers from different churches. The visit was supposed for attending a new floor dedication service. However, because of lack of proper lumber needed for the roof, the second floor did not get finished and no dedication took place. Instead the team went to attend a wedding ceremony of the pastor of "Oct. 3" church at another site. The church took on the name "Oct. 3" in memory of a massacre of local people by the Mexican army on Oct. 3 many years ago.

2009 is an important and joyful year for Hong Kong Ling Liang Church (HKLLC) because this is the 50th Anniversary of the church which was founded by Rev. Timothy Dzao and the church expansion project is about at the construction stage.

Philippines Bread of Life Christian Church

<u>Philippines Bread of Life Christian Church - Financial Support for the Philippines Ling-Liang Christian Academy due to Flood Damage during the September 26 Super Typhoon:</u>

According to the news, Philippines struggled with the aftermath of back-to-back typhoons that have left more than 600 dead. The storms hit Metro Manila directly. Landslides have buried villages and cutoff towns in the area.

There were some damages at the Philippines Bread of Life Christian Church (BLCC) in Don Pedro and the church's Christian Academy. According to Elder Freddie Wong, Jr. "The flood hit our Church building real high. Only 6 inches and the flood would reach the first floor ceiling... All the Bible references...were submerged for nearly six hours. Our pastor's books in his house were all submerged ...We have suspended classes in our church school because the teachers are still drying up what ever can be salvaged from the flood. Computers, TV, books, files even cabinet and tables, we got a small mountain of trash. ... We thank God for helping us to cope with the situation..."

According to Rev. Gil Batiancila, Pastor of Philippines BLCC, the estimated damaged cost alone for the Church's Academy is about US \$8,000.

The LLWWEMA committee had decided to send US \$1,000 to the BLCC. Please keep them in your prayer.
