- Opening Prayer – Paul Lam
- Determination of Quorum – A quorum was present.
- Approval of the Last LLWWEMA Committee Meeting Minutes – YK Ho made a motion to approve the minutes; it was seconded by David Chan and approved unanimously.
- Presentation: Status Reports from the Church Care VPs
 1. VP, Church Care ID – David Chan: David presented the Karawang, Indonesia Ling Liang church's plan to construct a school building. The church has the land and has raised approximately US\$300K but needs almost US\$1,000K more. Nettie Lintang has retired from the church and taken a teaching position at IMAN.
 2. VP, Church Care NAD – YK Ho: The NAD churches will send nine people on this year's mission trip to Nepal. The condition of the NAD churches was discussed. A couple of the churches need pastoral staff.
 3. VP, Church Care HKD – Jimmy Chui: The HK churches will send eleven people on this year's mission trip to Nepal. On July 27, 2017, the Australia Ling Liang church will be ordaining a pastor. Rev. Mok from Hong Kong will participate in the ordination.
 4. VP, Church Care AIMP – Paul Lam: Two people from the Philippine Ling Liang church will participate in the Nepal STM trip this year.
- Discussion and Status:
 1. The Karawang, Indonesia Ling Liang church's need for funds to construct a school building was discussed. Later this year a promotional program by the LLWWEMA will be conducted to encourage all Ling Liang churches to support this project.
 2. Treasurer report – Funding from Torrance BOL for the book project in the amount of US\$14,200 was received.
 3. LLWWEMA book *Never be Hungry, Never be Thirsty*
 - a. Sien Chong Wu has prepared a draft of the book. Ben Kirkup is proofreading the English version.
 - b. A publisher has been selected. Its price was the most attractive and the quality of its work is very good.
